- Referendum-Southington Water Pollution Control Facility Upgrade-Overview of project and projected cost. State of CT to provide a Grant of $\$ 17,168,000$ which is approx. $30 \%$ of $\$ 57,100,000$ project. In order to qualify referendum needs to be approved this November. Infrastructure was built in 1958 and is outdated and inefficient. The town must comply with new phosphorus limits by 2022 or may be subject to daily fines of $\$ 37,500$ or $\$ 13,687,500$ year. If approved in November estimated construction will occur between 2018-2020. Video presentation is available on the town website. Questions can be directed to Jim Grappone at (860)276-6232.
